Sub: Nomination for MAE-FETP and MPH Courses at NIE, Chennai – Reg.

National Institute of Epidemiology (NIE), an institute under Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), Department of Health Research, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, has been conducting the following two-year courses.

- (1) Master of Applied Epidemiology (MAE)
(Field Epidemiology Training Programme)
- Two-year programme with field placement for 18 months
- (2) Master of Public Health (MPH)
(Health Services Development and Research)
- Two-year full time residential programme

The above programmes are off-campus courses of Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute for Medical Sciences, Thiruvananthapuram, an institute of national importance under Government of India. The courses are recognized by Medical Council of India under first schedule of IMC Act.

Medical graduates (MBBS) working in Public Health in State or Central Departments with a minimum of three years experience are eligible. The selected candidates need to be deputed to NIE, Chennai, for a period of two years.

The courses are supported financially by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India and the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) and technically supported by the World Health Organization (WHO) and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Atlanta, USA.
